Sub: Reopening of Institute for Regular Classes of BFSc(NS) students- Reg:
Ref : Government of Kerala Order GO(Rt)No.1609/20-20/H.Edn. dtd 23.12.2020

As per the above cited Government Order, it has been decided to reopen the Institute, post Covid Lockdown, for conducting the regular classes for BFSc(NS) Degree students. Accordingly, the regular classes for BFSc (NS) VII semester students will commence on daily basis with effect from 04.01.2021 and for BFSc (NS) Semester I, III and V, regular classes will be held on alternate weeks as per the schedule below. Online classes will be continued for BFSc (NS) Semester I, III and V for the remaining period.

The Time table for the Regular and Online classes will be issued separately. Further, the students are also advised to make note of the following instructions:

1. All students have to strictly adhere to COVID protocols while in the Institute Campus and the Hostel.
2. All students have to produce an undertaking from their Parent/Guardian that while attending the regular classes in the Institute, their ward shall adhere to all SOPs and COVID protocols including social distancing, wearing masks, etc
3. Hostel facility will be available on regular basis for BFSc(NS) VII semester boy students, as per requirement, for the entire duration. For the other batches, Hostel Facility for boys will be restricted only for the period in which classes are conducted in Institute. However, boy students from outside Kerala can avail regular stay in hostel, as per availability, on first come-first serve basis.
4. During their stay in Hostel, inmates shall not be permitted for evening/weekends outings. They shall strictly adhere to social distancing and other protocols while in Hostel, especially in Mess Hall and other common places.
