**OFFICE ORDER**

Sub: Posting of BFSc(NS) students onboard the vessel – reg.

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The onboard practical training in the fishing vessel is an essential requirement as per the curriculum of the BFSc(NS) course. Based on the curriculum, the students are posted onboard the vessel regularly to acquire practical sailing knowledge. The DG(Shipping) also has approved BFSc(NS) course for appearing Mate Fishing Vessel Examination for issuance of CoC as Mate of fishing vessel under MS Rules 1987(as amended) provided the students should acquire six months sea service onboard fishing vessels of 24 m and above in length. The onboard practical exam is mandatory as per the curriculum and the students shall be required to take part minimum 24 days sailing during the 4 year course. As per the revised syllabus, the onboard practical examination is conducted in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> semester. Therefore, it has been decided that the BFSc(NS) students must acquire minimum 8 days of sailing in the 1<sup>st</sup> year before appearing the second semester exam and 16 days of sailing in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year before appearing the 7<sup>th</sup> semester exam. The loss of sailing days may be recouped by the students through sailing onboard before completion of 7<sup>th</sup> semester examination. If the vessel is laid up in the harbour, 2 days of working days in the vessel at harbour will be considered as one day sailing. If any shortage in the sailing days, the students will be debarred from appearing onboard exam or proportionate marks will be deducted as decided by the Competent Authority. The sea service will be maintained and recorded in the TAR book duly signed by the Skipper & OIC(Operation).
