**Vacancy Notification**

Applications are invited for filling up of **02 posts of Netmaker (01 post is Reserved for SC and 01 post for OBC)** on Direct Recruitment basis in Level 1 in the Pay Matrix (ie. in the pre-revised pay band -1 Rs.5200-20200+ Grade pay of Rs.1800/-) (Group 'C' Non-Gazetted Non-Ministerial). The post will be initially filled on a temporary basis and later regularized depending upon administrative requirements. The initial place of posting for one post (**i.e. the post reserved for SC**) will be at Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh, and the other post (**i.e. the post reserved for OBC**) will be at Chennai, Tamil Nadu. However the posts comes with the liability to serve any where in India. The age limit (as on closing date) for the post shall be between 18 and 25 years of age. The qualification required for the post is (1) Pass in X<sup>th</sup> Standard. (2) Experience in net making and net maintenance. Age relaxation shall be admissible for both the posts as per the orders issued by Government of India as amended from time to time.
